Starting a new life after violence and abuse is challenging all on its own, but not being able to find an affordable place to live adds more stress.

We knew Stepping Stones could help ease that stress with our transitional housing

options.

At the end of 2023, we were able to increase our total number of transitional housing units to 9 twobedroom two-bathroom units! This allows for up to 18 families (depending on size of family and specific needs) from our safe emergency shelter to continue living with us for up to two years while they work hard to get back on their feet, gain a rental history, and get more support from our advocates. # HOPE FOR A SAFE, BRIGHT FUTURE

Finding hope in the middle of trauma and chaos can often be impossible for the families we serve. But when they come to Stepping Stones, they have the opportunity to take a breath, debrief, and begin to work toward a life filled with hope and freedom from all forms of abuse. Adults complete an anonymous survey upon exit to provide feedback. From January 1 through March 31, 2024, they reported:

100% reported they are (re)gaining control of their lives.

100% reported they have an increased knowledge of domestic violence and its effects on their life.

100% reported they know how to plan for their continued safety.

100% reported they felt confident they would be free from abuse even after leaving Stepping Stones.



Under Titles VI and VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI and VII) and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, Stepping Stones Agencies prohibits discrimination in admissions, programs, services, activities or employment based on race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, and disability. Stepping Stones must make a reasonable accommodation to allow a person with a disability to take part in a program, service, or activity.
